Recommendation 1:

During the visit there was only one person on the reception desk, while the queue had 15 people plus, which meant that it stretched out of the door. The Surgery look at increasing the number of Reception staff available during peak periods. Has this recommendation been met? Yes X No \Box

2 Receptionists now support the reception desk during busy morning peak time of 8.15 - 9.15, which has improved the service.



Recommendation 2:

The Surgery to consider utilising the television screen to communicate patient waiting times.

Comments:

The Practice Manager explained that he had queried this with the company that provides the television screen service, but the appointment system and television screen systems are not compatible, so this is not possible.

The practice does however communicate patient waiting times via the check-in screen display or, if a patient checks in via Reception then the Receptionist informs them of waiting times.

The Surgery to work with the Patient Participation Group to update the Surgery leaflet.

The surgery leaflet is currently being updated due to staff changes, so was unavailable to view.

- 8 GPs (full time) and 1 locum
- 6 Practice Nurses and 1 Advanced Nurse Practitioner
- 2 Healthcare Assistants and 1 Phlebotomist
- 10 Reception staff and 8 admin staff
